Art has always accompanied me, through colours, music, and shapes. My casual contact with the Academy of Fine Arts in my hometown, my early fascination with detail through the paintings of Zdzisław Beksiński, the ability to make use of randomly captured impressions, and my love for nature and symbolism inspired my own artistic journey.

I was born in Poland but moved to Sydney in 2007. Traveling and curiosity have always been a part of my life. I have worked in various fields: teaching, marketing, the travel industry, and individual

support, and have always been passionate about creativity and new, unusual forms of expression.

I am a self-taught artist, but I have always been surrounded by art. As a German language lecturer at the University of Łódź, I used painting as an analogy to literature, as a didactic element in the interpretation of works. Today, I create my own art pieces influenced by nature, micro and macro spaces, and symbolism.

Artist Statement

When I create sculptures, I want them to tell their own story. Unlike paintings, each sculpture is a combination of realism and symbolism. The sculptures refer to the connection between humans and nature or depict the human form as a sublime phenomenon, where every curve and motion is beautiful and expressive on its own.

My current paintings reflect a fascination with diffusing and blending shapes in micro and macro spaces. I love texture, multi-layered compositions, and I try to visualize the unspoken. I believe that in the process of painting or sculpting, each piece begins to speak its own language, revealing hidden depths that escaped our senses at first glance. Following the unknown is part of the experience. This is why I called my website: Wade in Unknown.
